### **COURSE RULES**

The course does not allow you to bring in outside beverages (bottled water is OK). They will staff beverage carts on the course and have two large food/beverage trailers near the clubhouse. If you plan to hand out beverages, bring a cooler for the beer you buy from the course. Ice is free at the course.

### **PARTICIPATION, PAYMENTS & PRIZES**

Fourteen on-course activities will take place at the tournament, with each player having the opportunity to partake in eight of those challenges. On-course activities are included in the registration fee for the event.

The prizes for the “Tee Shot on the Green” contests are typically a sleeve of golf balls or another prize at the discretion of the hole sponsor running the event. For the other Challenges, prizes will be provided by the firms running the event. Feel free to bring other miscellaneous prizes that you may want to give the players or award based on any side games you choose to run.

## **EVENT DETAILS**

*Tee Shot on the Green* - A player hitting their tee shot onto the green gets a sleeve of golf balls or other prize that will be given to them at the hole they are playing. Golf balls or other prizes will be provided by the firm running the challenge. No Mulligans are allowed.

*Putting Challenge, held on the Practice Putting Green* - Each participant will get a set number of putts. For each putt made, their name will go into a drawing for the prize that will be given away following the event.

*Chipping Challenge, set-up near the Clubhouse* - Players will get a set number of attempts to chip into a bullseye. If they get their ball in the target, their name is entered into a drawing for the prize. If they make more than one ball into the target, their name is entered once for each successful shot.

## **Event Notes**

- We are planning for over 200 golfers this year. The plan is to run two concurrent events with 100+ golfers on each course. Please bring enough golf balls or prizes to handle prizes for all.
- Bring all the supplies you will need to manage your game. Some of the items that have been helpful in past years include:
  - Coolers to keep beverages cold
  - Lawn chairs
  - Table(s)
  - Umbrellas or tent
  - Prizes (other than golf balls) to hand out
  - Golf balls
  - Snacks for the golfers
  - \$\$ for change in case players who skipped paying at registration decide to play your event
- We will be on the Silver and Gold Courses at Emerald Greens.
- Volunteers working the on-course Challenges may get a cart to haul things to their hole.
